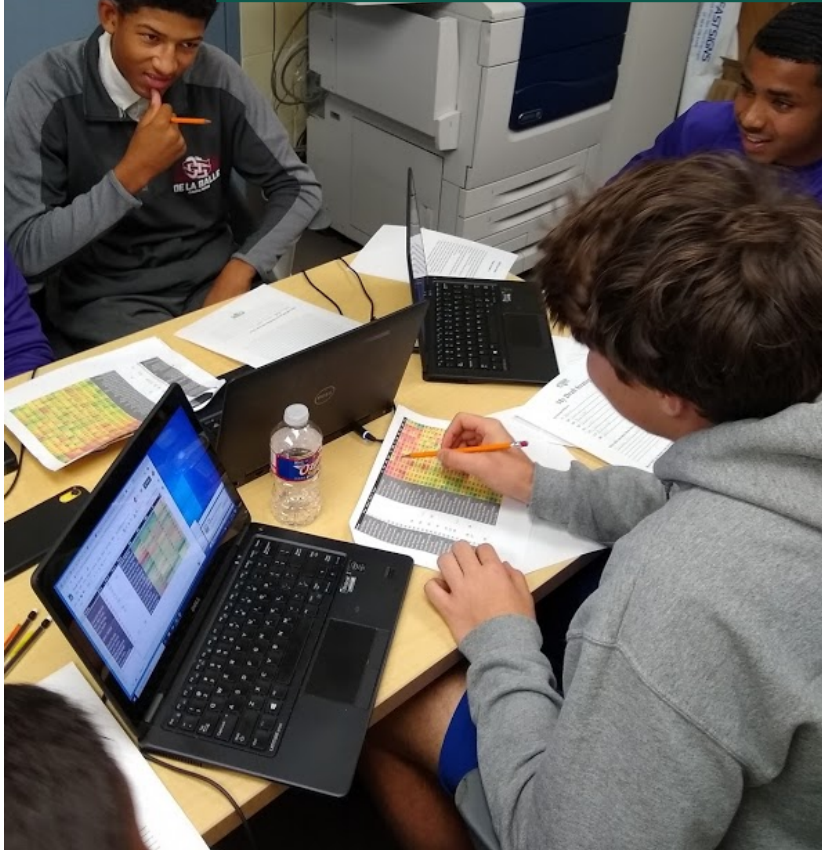

## Overview

The **Business and Legal Side of Baseball** educates students about statistical analysis, law, mathematics, medicine, and expands their academic and potential career horizons. Our online courses connect students with experts from Tulane University and their peers from youth academies across the country.

## Sports Medicine Certificate

Students will explore the world of sports medicine, focusing on the specific roles of each member of the sports medicine team including athletic trainers, physical therapists, physicians, and many others. Students will discover the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of sports injuries most often seen in baseball. Students will use their explorations and the decision-making process to design injury management and injury prevention plans for athletes of all levels.
